Environmental Science Archives

A. TEAM FORMATION

- 1. Guest Editor (1 or 2)
- 2. Editorial team (3-10 members, Will be made by Guest Editor)
- 3. An editorial member of ESA (Will be decided by ESA) for communication between Guest Team and ESA.

B. WORKFLOW

1. Process for the Guest Editor/s

- a. Call for papers on the proposed theme via email or Whatsapp at environmentalsciencearchives@gmail.com
- b. If papers received by ESA under theme, these will be sent to Guest Editor.
- c. Receive numbered papers from ESA and send the papers to editorial members for review.
- d. Get the papers reviewed within stipulated time
- e. If author pays APC, get the paper corrected from author
- f. Send the corrected papers to ESA Editorial member for further PDF typesetting and receive the galley proof.
- g. Send galley proof to author for final check.
- h. Final Online Publication

2. Process for Editorial Members

- a. Receive the papers for review from the Guest Editor
- b. Review papers
- c. Send back the Comments to Guest Editor

3. Process for Authors

- a. Submit paper to ESA under special issue of the Guest Editor
- b. Receive review results from the Guest Editor within 2 weeks
- c. Revise the paper and send it back to Guest Editor
- d. Pay Article Processing Fee
- e. Receive Galley Proof
- f. Correct if needed
- g. Get the paper published
